ONLINE One-to-One-Tutoring: Strategies for Writing Scientific Papers (C1)

Weekly 1hour appointment slots with an English language expert are available for doctoral students of the natural sciences who are preparing their own scientific papers or other scientific texts. Those attending 10 consultations receive a certificate of attendance, approx. 30-hours workload total.

Description:

One-to-one tutoring provides an opportunity for doctoral students to assess and improve their English writing skills individually under the guidance of a qualified teacher.

Improving your scientific writing skills is a process that begins with establishing, first of all, where you are. This individual attention to your writing development, with the support of a tutor, is the first step to improving not only your current text, but your overall success as a writer of academic English. With the help of a customized corpus and other self-study tools, writers can analyse their own writing in comparison to others in their field and independently improve their overall writing skills.

The tutoring programme aims to achieve the following:

- Raise your awareness of your strengths and weaknesses in English scientific writing
- Re-establish (where necessary) the basic rules of English scientific writing
- Examine the linearity of written communication and the structure of English texts
- Examine the conventions of subject-specific publications; the pre-requisites of "IMRAD"
- Investigate (where necessary) citation conventions and plagiarism

You Will Need:

- Your own computer/internet connection with video conference ability!
- TEN PEER-REVIEWED PAPERS FROM YOUR FIELD, written by native scientific writers (pdf or text files)
- Your TEXT, TASK, or WRITING PLAN you want to discuss
