

Module registration via lottery (random selection) in WiSe 2021/2022

Information for Plant Science students

The procedure

As from the summer semester (SoSe) 2021, the module placements for the **Elective Modules** are assigned to **StudIP**. Different to before, this time you can specify how many elective modules you would like to take and **sort them by priority**. StudIP will consider your chosen priority for the placement. For the lottery it is not relevant at what point during the registration period you have entered. After the draw, you will see in your StudIP account which modules you got. It can happen that you will not get a place in a module directly. If this is the case, you are on the waiting list. You can move up as soon as someone else unsubscribes from the module. **Therefore, please be fair to your fellow students**. If you do not want to take one of your modules anymore (e.g. because it overlaps with another module of yours) please unsubscribe early from this module!

Registration deadline and lottery

Registration period on StudIP, **15th of September 2021 7:00 am until 22nd of September 2021, 12:00 noon**

The raffle will take place on the **22nd of September 2021 at 12:59 pm**.

You can unsubscribe from the modules until the **6th of October 2021, 12:59 pm**.

FAQ

Where can I find the module registration and what exactly do I need to do? As long as the required course is part of this procedure for the elective modules, the module registration will open automatically as soon as you open the course on StudIP and have clicked at "Go to course". You can find further details in the picture description below.

What do I have to take into account for my module choice?

There are some elective modules that are exclusively for Plant Biotechnology students (M.Sc. Pbt) or exclusively for International Horticulture students (M.Sc. IntHort). To avoid any problems, please make sure that you **only select modules you can actually take according to your degree program**. If you are not sure which modules are dedicated to your degree program, please have a look at the timetable or/and module catalogue. Both can be found on the respective website of the degree program. The **assignment to the major** must also be paid attention to. In addition, please consider temporal overlaps in the timetable.

Annotation for M.Sc. Pbt students: The modules „Funktionale Genomanalyse pflanzlicher Symbiosen“ and "Methoden und Anwendungen der funktionalen Genomanalysen in Pflanzen“ can not be taken together.

Are all modules from my degree program included in this registration procedure?

The new registration procedure includes **only the elective modules**. This procedure will not draw any placement for compulsory modules, key qualifications, research modules etc. Please inform yourself which other modules you have to take and how you can register for them.

Annotation for M.Sc. IntHort students: The modules „Foundation of Sustainable Development. Planing, Management and Evaluation of Projects“, „Horticulture and Environment Economics and Policy“ and “Sustainability Management” are not included in this registration procedure and must be selected separately.

Some modules consists of seminar, lecture and internship. Where do I register?

The module registration for the elective modules takes place exclusively on StudIP. Usually you need to register for the lecture to register for the whole module.

How many modules can I take?

You can take maximum of five modules out of this registration set. If you want to take less than five, you can specify this directly at your registration (see 2nd step above).

One of the lecturers is my supervisor for my thesis. Does StudIP take this into account for the placement?

If you would like to take a course held by the lecturer you are writing you bachelor or master thesis with, it could be considered for the placement. For this, please contact your lecturer preferably **at the beginning of the registration period**. A consideration after the registration deadline is not possible.

I have done the internship for a module already but would like to hear the lecture again. Where can I specify that?
In that case, please contact the relevant lecturer.

I got a place in a module which I do not want to take anymore. What do I need to do?

You can unsubscribe from the module within two weeks. For this, you need to sign out of the course-group on StudIP. Your fellow students on the waiting list will be happy to move up. After the two weeks deadline, the unsubscribing is only possible in exceptional cases (e.g. if the course has not started yet).
